

## ***Suffolk Constabulary Report 2021***

Suffolk Constabulary has recorded a total of 5 investigations for Sweffling for this period which compares with 1 for the same period for the preceding twelve months.

The 5 investigations for the period 2020/2021 are of the types shown below;

July 2020 – 1 x Burglary

August 2020 – 1 x Criminal Damage

October 2020 – 1 x Anti-Social Behaviour, 1 x Violence / Sexual Offence

January 2021 – 1 x Burglary

For the same period 2019/2020, we have one investigation recorded for Sweffling (ASB)

Phishing scams are those originating by e-mail and usually involve trying to get the recipient to click a link which then goes to a webpage which covertly downloads software to the victim's computer to acquire personal details and access to confidential sites such as bank accounts.
