Description: Area of land around 0.8 acres to the south of Holden's Lane Sweffling behind Blyth Villas that was bought from Suffolk Coastal District Council in March 2011 to be used for a village amenity for £1.

A survey of the village at the time rejected using the land for allotments - not enough support and no water available.

The Parish Council decided to use the land for the enjoyment of local villagers to include a children's play area; picnic tables and other seating; and the possibility of a community orchard.

The building of 4 Homes by Orwell Housing in 2014/2015 enabled SPC to clear the site of blackthorn roots and suckers; level the ground and fence and hedge the field at the entrance through Jubilee Close - payback from Orwell Housing for using our land as a carpark.

Old swings were removed, new ones acquired and a climbing trail added in 2015/16. Local sports trainers suggested we put in adult training equipment in 2016 and this has recently been added to in 2021/22.

Present use is for the enjoyment of all villagers, their families and local walkers. The play equipment is well maintained and a regular grass cutting regime is in place. Currently SPC have been advised by Suffolk Wildlife Trust as to how to improve the insect life on the field and areas are being managed for wildlife.
